## 2025 Regional Conferences

Since the early to mid-1980s, in an effort to establish more cohesive Regions within the global Church of the Nazarene, each of the six Regions has organized a Regional Conference, held on the Region in the years between General Assemblies. Typically, Regional Conferences are planned by the Region, on the Region, and for the development of the Region. Often, the various ministries have time to present and hold workshops or sessions to promote those ministries for greater effectiveness. In some Regions, there have been Regional Theology Conferences that occur prior to, during, or after the Regional Conference to deepen theological awareness and coherence, with Regional perspectives informing the theological conversation. Regional Conferences are always a time of renewed fellowship, growing strategic alignment, and deep spiritual commitment to the worship of God and the mission of the Church of the Nazarene. This year, in February, there was the M25 Conference in the US/Canada Region, with a focus on Gospel: Bringing People to Jesus. These M-Conferences are the US/Canada equivalent to other Regional Conferences on other Regions around the world. There are three remaining Regional Conferences between July and December 2025: July-Asia Pacific, October-South America, and November-Eurasia. Nazarene Missions International will be at these conferences to meet NMI leaders on each Region, share plans for the future of NMI, and begin to make preparations for the 2027 Global NMI Convention.
